"For girls, the greatest challenge in education is absenteeism that is related to Kenya of Education,

"A girl misses 4 days a month due to menses. This equates to 2 weeks per term and 6 weeks during a school year" - Ministry of Education, Kenya

- Primary school: 18 weeks of learning lost within 3 years
- Secondary school: 24 weeks of learning lost within 4 years

Girls absenteeism is

- directly linked to the onset of: Poorer grades vs. boys
- Increased sexual activity, **HIV**
- Early pregnancy

- Female Genital Mutilation Verbal abuse (at home and school)
- Child labour
